Fire Chief Pantalone:

The department finished up two reports, one from the ISO (Insurance Service Organization) and the other from the BWC safety assessment. Both reports came out good. This does have an effect on the home owners and commercial property insurance rates.

Public Works Foreman Kris Dillon:

All the department's equipment is ready for the winter. The project on Old Farm Rd has not been started.

Zoning Director Dan Morgan:

The Zoning Department issued 15 permits totaling \$133,000 in tax value in the past month. The Zoning Department has completed 43 inspections. There are 62 cases still open. Some will have to wait until the spring to finish.

Another reminder to please take the township's survey. We are asking our employees who live in the township to also take the survey.

Fiscal Officer Thomas Krispinsky:

We'll be having an outside firm doing the Township's audit for the 2021 and 2022 years. The name of the firm is Charles E. Harris and Associates out of Cleveland. They will start sometime in January.
